

Modern Slavery Statement

Risk awareness and ethical supply-chain expectations

Statement

PROFM recognises the importance of preventing modern slavery and unethical labour practices. The organisation does not tolerate forced labour, human trafficking or modern slavery in any form.

Risk assessment

PROFM operates primarily within Australia and engages a local supply chain. Given the nature and scale of operations and the use of Australian-based subcontractors operating under their own ABN, the current risk of modern slavery is considered low. Low risk does not remove the need for awareness and review.

Supplier expectations

Contractors and subcontractors are expected to comply with applicable laws relating to fair and lawful work practices and to raise concerns about suspected exploitation or unlawful conduct.

Commitment and review

PROFM will remain alert to modern-slavery risks and review or strengthen its measures if its operations, services or supply chain change.
